THE TWELVE DAYS OF CHRISTMAS

Some Christian insight on "The Twelve Days of Christmas" for you to ponder. First, who gives the gifts? The song calls this giver "My True Love". The one who loves you and gives you many things each day is God. James 1:17.

- **Day 1:** Let the partridge in a pear tree remind you of Jesus, the best Christmas gift of all, who died for us on the cross. John 3:16.
- **Day 2:** Let the two turtledoves remind you of the two doves given to God when Baby Jesus was first brought to the temple. Luke 2:22, 24
- **Day 3:** Let the three French hens remind you of the three costly gifts given to Jesus by the Wise Men. Matt. 2:10-11
- **Day 4:** Let the four calling birds remind you of Matthew, Mark, Luke and John and the four special books they wrote. John 19:9-10
- **Day 5:** Let the five golden rings remind you of five valuable books of the Bible: Gen., Exodus, Levit., Numbers, Deut. Psalm 19:9-10
- Day 6: Let six geese laying eggs remind you of the new life God made in the first six days of creation. Gen. 1:31
- **Day 7:** Let seven swimming swans remind you of the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit: 1. Gift of prophecy 2. Gift of serving 3. Gift of teaching 4. Telling others how they should live 5. Giving to those who are in need 6. Gift of leadership 7. Gift of showing mercy. Romans 12:6-8

- **Day 8:** Let eight maids a-milking remind you of the eight Beatitudes: 1. Blessed are those who are spiritually needy 2. Blessed are those who are sad 3. Blessed are those who are free of pride 4. Blessed are those who are hungry and thirsty for what is right 5. Blessed are those who show mercy 6. Blessed are those whose hearts are pure 7. Blessed are those who make peace 8. Blessed are those who suffer for doing what is right. Matt. 5:3-10
- **Day 9:** Let nine ladies dancing remind you of the nine qualities that God's Holy Spirit produces in your life: love, joy and peace (1-3), being patient, kind and good (4-6), being faithful and gentle (7-8), having control of oneself (9) Gal. 5:22-23
- **Day 10:** Let ten leaping lords remind you of the Ten Commandments which we are to obey. Exodus 20:2-17
 - **Day 11:** Let eleven pipers piping help you to remember to follow Jesus. Mark 3:16-19
- **Day 12:** Let twelve drummers drumming remind you of the Apostle's Creed 12 important beliefs of Christians: I believe in God the Father Almighty, maker of heaven and earth. I believe in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell; the third day He rose from the dead. He ascended into heaven and sits at the right hand of God the Father. He shall return to judge both the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting.

Years went by. They were cut down, put in woodpiles, and forgotten.


