TODAY IS YOUR BEST DAY BECAUSE YOU ARE IN CHRIST

God alone made it possible for you to be in Christ Jesus. For our benefit God made Christ to be wisdom itself. He is the One who made us acceptable to God. He made us pure and holy, and He gave Himself to purchase our freedom. I Corinthians 1:30 NLT

Different people use different measurements to evaluate their day. A salesman may land a big account and call it his best day. An athlete may break a record in his sport and call it his best day. A woman may marry the man of her dreams and call it her best day. A writer may have her first book published and call it her best day.

As a child of God, however, today is your best day because you are in Christ. You may be a salesman who landed a big account today, or may have made no sale at all. Your best day is not founded in what you've accomplished, but in who you are in Christ.

Being in Christ means that He is the atmosphere in which you live your day.

I was recently in a large conference room for a staff meeting. Because I was *in* the room, the atmosphere of the room had an influence upon me. The room had padded chairs to sit upon. The lighting in the room was soft and inviting. The colors on the walls were pleasing to the eye. Best of all, the room was air-conditioned, making everyone inside feel comfortable, even though it was hot outside.

Because you are *in* Christ, everything that is true about Christ will have an impact upon you. It is in Him that you live and move and have your being. As you go through this day, consider all that is yours because you are in Christ.

- You stand before God with your past forgiven and forgotten.
- Your life is under His ownership and watch-care.
- You have been brought into union and fellowship with God.
- You have no cloud of condemnation hanging over your head.
- You are no longer a slave to the sins that once had you bound.
- You are covered by the love of God from every direction.
- You are God's child and a part of God's family of believers.
- You have been set apart for God's special purpose.
- You can see life with a heavenly point of view.
- You are in God's strong hands.
- You travel on paths of victory as you walk with your hand in His.
- You have a new calling, a new purpose, and a new direction.
- You overflow with spiritual blessings.
- You live under and in the authority of Jesus.
- You are showered with grace and kindness.
- You are God's masterpiece in the making.
- You have a relationship with Jesus that will never end.
- You can go through this day clothed with the righteousness of Christ.

Into your hands I commit my spirit; you will**

redeem me, O Lord, O faithful God.' Psalm 31:4-5. These are some things that we can only learn from God. The Spirit teaches us to pray and to know the steadfast love of God."

FACE IT – DON'T FEAR IT!

It is easy for us to be caught up in the daily difficulties we experience, and sometimes we want to withdraw and avoid the conflict of facing our giants. But we should not be intimidated by these challenges. Rather, we should depend on the power of God to overcome these situations, and we must rely on His Word and follow the instructions set before us in Scripture.

- **1. Take up the shield and face your fear head on.** Do not be afraid . . . I am your shield, your exceedingly great reward. Genesis 15:1b
- **2. Know that God hears and will come to assist.** *Fear not, for God has heard the voice of the lad where he is.* Genesis 21:17
- **3. Face the challenge head on.** Look, the LORD your God has set the land before you; go up and possess it, as they LORD God of your fathers has spoken to you; do not fear or be discouraged. Deuteronomy 1:21
- **4. Don't be intimidated by the giants you face.** *Today you are on the verge of battle with your enemies. Do not let your heart faint, o not be afraid, and do not tremble or be terrified because of them.* Deuteronomy 20:3
- **5. Stay the course!** Be strong and of good courage, and do it; do not fear nor be dismayed, for the LORD God my God will be with you. He will not leave you nor forsake you, until you have finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

- **6.** Remember that God will always be with you. For I, the LORD your God, will hold your right hand, saying to you, "Fear not, I will help you.' Isaiah 41:13
- **7. Be assured of who you are in Christ.** *Fear not, for I have redeemed you; I have called you by your name; you are Mine.* Isaiah 43:1
- **8. Don't give your earthly giants too much credit! Greater is He that is in you!** *And do not fear those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. But rather fear Him who is able to destroy both soul and body in hell.* Matthew 10:28
- **9.** Remember that God knows what you're going through, and He loves you and desires to help you overcome. But the very hairs of your head are all numbered. Do not fear therefore; you are of more value than many sparrows. Luke 12:7
- **10.God will always be there for you.** *Do not be afraid; I am the First and the Last.* Revelation 1:17b


